Choose a healthy meal that you enjoy eating.

Draw and label the foods in your meal and explain:

Which food groups they belong to.
Why they are important for the body.
How they help us stay healthy.

RE – What are important times for Jewish people?

Find out about a Jewish celebration and why it is important.

Create a poster or fact-file to explain:

- What the celebration is.
- Why it is important.
- How it is celebrated.
