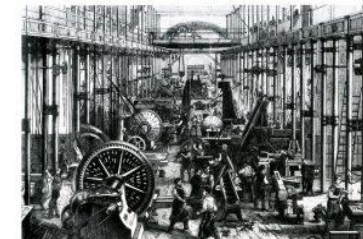


Industrial Revolution

When creating your model, think about the following questions: What does your factory produces? Who works at your factory? What do they look like? How will you get this across in your model?	Rate 5 inventions of the Industrial Revolution and rank their importance. Give your reasons. You will have to do some research. How could you present this in an exciting and engaging way?
Write a biography about Queen Victoria. What interesting facts can you find out about her? What was she remembered for? You could present this in a presentation, a fact file, a booklet – be creative!	Can you build a model of a steam train and explain how it works? How will you make your steam train eye-catching to onlookers but also fit for purpose?	Can you design an outfit for an upper-class person and a working-class person during the Industrial Revolution – you will have to do some research! After you have done this, I would like you to explain how these differed and why you think this was.
